Whereas I, the undersigned, am of opinion, on the grounds specified

GROUNDS

The Board of Trustees of the Mormugao Port vide Resolution No. 130 of  
25.03.2009 have resolved that the Kharewada fishing jetty is to be closed down  
at the earliest due to grave security threat to MPT, and in any case not later than  
31.10.2009. This has been reconfirmed by the Board in its meeting on  
28/10/2009. However, the fishing jetty is still existing and the operations are not  
stopped.

NOW, therefore, in pursuance of Sub-Section (I) of Section 4 of the Act. I  
hereby call upon you to show cause on or before 18/12/2009, why an order of  
eviction should not be made.

In pursuance of Clause (b)(ii) of Sub-Section 2 of Section 4, I also call  
upon you to appear before me in person or through a duly authorized  
representative capable to answer all material questions connected with the  
matter along with the evidence which you intend to produce in support of the  
cause shown, on 22/12/2009 at 10.30 am for personal hearing. Incase, you fail  
to appear on the said date and time, the case will be decided exparte.
