REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE/SEWWAGE BY
DULY LICENSED CONTRACTORS BY THE MORMUGAO MUNICIPAL
COUNCIL(MMC)

MPT PROPOSES TO OUTSOURCE THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF NON-HAZARDOUS GARBAGE AND SEWAGE AS PER ANNEX-V AND ANNEX-VI OF MARPOL 73/78 RESPECTIVELY FROM ALL KINDS OF SHIPS, BY CONTRACTORS DULY LICENCED BY MMC TO COLLECT AND DISPOSE GARBAGE TO THE DESIGNATED DUMPING YARD / PLANT. IT MAY BE NOTED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITY WILL BE OUTSOURCED AS PER THE LEAST QUOTATION RECEIVED FOR THAT ACTIVITY –

1. COLLECTION AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE/SEWAGE FROM SHIPS ALONG SIDE BERTHS.
2. COLLECTION AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE/SEWAGE FROM SHIPS AT MOORING DOLPHINS & EAST OF BREAKWATER ANCHORAGE.
3. COLLECTION AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE/SEWAGE FROM SHIPS AT WEST OF BREAKWATER ANCHORAGE.

IT HAS BEEN INFORMED TO THE DEPUTY CONSERVATOR THAT DUE TO THE ABNORMAL HIGH CHARGES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE MANY SHIPS ARE DISPOSING THIS GARBAGE INTO THE WATER AT NIGHT THEREBY POLLUTING OUR WATERS AND VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF MARPOL 73/78 CONVENTION TO WHICH INDIA IS SIGNATORY TO.

IN ORDER TO STREAMLINE THE RECEPTION FACILITY TO COMPLY WITH MARPOL CONVENTION, IT IS PROPOSED TO CALL FOR COMPETITIVE QUOTATION FROM CONTRACTORS LICENSED TO COLLECT SUCH GARBAGE/SEWAGE FROM FIRMS LICENSED BY THE MMC.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE QUOTATIONS ARE ATTACHED AS ANNEXURE-I. AVAILABLE AT OUR WEBSITE OR FROM THE OFFICE OF THE UNDERSIGNED

THE APPLICATIONS FOR QUALIFICATION MAY BE SUBMITTED ON OR BEFORE 1100 HRS ON 14TH JULY, 2010 TO THE DEPUTY CONSERVATOR, MORMUGAO PORT TRUST IN TWO COVER SYSTEM, DULY ENCLOSING A COPY OF SUCH LICENCE AND EXPERIENCE IN COVER-I AND THE PRICES QUOTED FOR EACH ACTIVITY IN COVER- II. THE SAME WILL BE OPENED AT 1200 HRS. ON 14TH JULY, 2010.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Rate quoted by contractor must include the cost of material, labour, transport etc.
2. The lorry/boat with valid Licence, Registration, Road tax, Insurance, etc should be arranged by contractor. The copy of the certificates to be submitted for verification.
3. The required labour, materials etc. should be arranged by contractor.
4. **The Port Trust shall not be responsible for any payment to the Agent for collecting & disposal of Garbage/Sewage from the ships.** However, the payment should be settled by the shipping Agent (or) Master of the Ship.
5. Permission of the Deputy Conservator or his authorized representative should be obtained before collection of garbage/sewage from the vessel.
6. The Contractor shall ensure that the collecting & disposal of Garbage/sewage from the ships will be undertaken without causing any hindrance to Port/ship activities.
7. The Contractor shall bear the cost of damages if any caused by him or by his employee to any properties of the Port or Port employee.
8. The Contractor for collection of non-hazardous garbage shall undertake the work with the permission of Port Authorities, Master of the vessel through concerned Shipping agent, Customs Authorities, CISF and Mormugao Municipal Council where dumping yard is located for every act of collection.
9. The Port reserves the right to alter the conditions of the permission and even cancels the permission at any point of time without assigning any reason thereof.
10. The garbage/sewage should be carried in open truck with proper covering as per statutory regulations to approved dumping yard of Mormugao Municipal Council. The Contractor should submit the complete report to the Dy. Conservator at the time taking permission furnishing the details of garbage such as name of the ship, date, type & weight of garbage/sewage, no. of bags etc. collected from the ships. The copy of receipt from MMC to be submitted to the undersigned.

The employees arranged by Contractor should not be involved in any police case. The details of employees to be furnished.
